Dr. William M. Leary, the E. Merton Coulter Professor of History, Emeritus, at the University of Georgia, will provide the 2005 Jalonick Memorial Distinguished Lecture. His lecture about Air America is central to the McDermott Library's Civil Air Transport/Air America Collection and Memorial located in the Special Collections Department. Dr. Leary has written histories of the China National Aviation Corp., Civil Air Transport, and the U.S. Air Mail Service. In 1995 he received the Central Intelligence Agency Studies in Intelligence Award for an Outstanding Contribution to the Literature of Intelligence. He served as Charles A.
